We are pleased to invite you to the 21st Scientific Convention of the International Gestalt Theory Association (GTA) in Warsaw. The convention is dedicated to the phenomenon of motion in its entire breadth of expressions. Its focus will be processuality of movement, motivation, emotion and communication in different areas of experience (among others: philosophy of body, intersubjectivity, psychological and psychotherapeutic experience, sport, dance, language). Both perspectives of moving and being-moved will be taken into account: not just as physical phenomena, but also as inner and outer movements of development.
